BEQUESTS TO KING'S COLLEGE.

Mrs. LINA OLYMPIA LEITNER, of the Oriental Institute, Woking, Surrey, who died on May 24, aged 64, widow of Dr. Gottlieb William Leitner, left estate of the gross value of £8,820, of which the net personalty has been sworn at £8,739. She left £800 upon trust for investment and to apply the income as to three guineas per annum in the upkeep of her grave and that of her husband and her mother, £5 per annum to King's College, London, to continue the prizes for Messianic Prophecies in memory of her father-in-law, Johann Leitner, and the balance of the income, subject to one life interest, to King's College, London, upon trust for prizes in Arabic in memory of her husband, to be awarded to students attending the School of Oriental Languages at King's College.
