LADY EVELYN COBBOLD

Lady Evelyn Cobbold died in a nursing home at Inverness on Friday. She had all the ingredients of the indomitable British lady traveller. When over the age of 60 she, who had been a Muslim for many years, undertook the pilgrimage to Mecca. She recounted the story in a book written in diary form and published in 1934 Pilgrimage to Mecca. The following year she published Kenya; The Land of Illusion, based on extensive travels during a visit of some months.

Lady Evelyn, the eldest daughter of the seventh Earl of Dunmore and sister of the present Earl, was born in 1867. In 1891 she married John Dupuis Cobbold, who

died in 1929.
